

The new two-year post-masters is called Design for Agrifood & Ecological Systems. The first group of ten students began their programme on Monday, 23 January. Femke Brouwer coordinates the new programme. 'EngD is a programme that can be followed after completing a master's, much like a PhD. A PhD focuses on acquiring new scientific knowledge, while EngD is all about applying existing and new scientific knowledge to design practical technological solutions. In short: PhD students conduct fundamental research, while EngD students apply fundamental knowledge to design practical solutions.'
