Contract governing the transfer of seed of the CGN special tomato collection (CGNSC001)

In promoting the use of plant genetic resources for food and agriculture CGN manages a special collection of seeds of tomato plants for which the entire genome sequence has been determined and published. The availability of total genome sequence data should facilitate the identification of specific traits and their selection in breeding programmes.

The undersigned, dr. T.J.L van Hintum, representing the Centre for Genetic Resources, the Netherlands (hereafter CGN) and provider, and xx, representing YY, and recipient, agree as follows.

- 1. CGN makes the Material (see Annex) available to YY for further research and/or breeding and for marketing products incorporating traits from the Material.
- 2. YY declares not to transfer the Material to third parties.
- 3. CGN will provide AA seeds of each individual accession to YY.
- 4. YY will pay to CGN a total sum of ZZ euros, for which CGN will provide an invoice.
- 5. CGN declares that it has full authority over the Material and that no third parties are known with potential claims on benefit-sharing following the use of the Material for the purpose of product development.
- 6. Separate from this contract, CGN and YY also sign a contract containing all terms and conditions of the Standard Material Transfer Agreement belonging to the Multilateral System of the International Plant Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (SMTA).
- 7. CGN declares that the due diligence obligations of YY contained in the EU Regulation 511/2014 on the implementation of the Nagoya Protocol in the European Union have been fulfilled by signing the SMTA of the Treaty, and that the compliance obligations of this Regulation do not apply.
- 8. This contract and the SMTA provide all conditions applicable to the transfer of the Material.
