Academic calendar

The autumn semester is organized in 2 periods: August block (one intensive three-week course) and Autumn parallel (September – December).

The spring semester is organized in 3 periods: January block (one intensive three-week course), Spring parallel (February – May) and June block (one intensive three-week course).

During the blocks it is only possible to take one course, since all the exams of the block will take place on the same day. It is not mandatory to sign up for a course in the blocks. The students can meet the fulltime studies requirement (30ECTS/semester) with courses only in the parallels.
